International Conference: "Earth's Fields and their Influence on Organisms" June 15–18, 2017

The Second Circular and Invitation

It is an offer to You to participate in the 19th International Conference on "Earth's Fields and their Influence on Organisms", which will be held in Birštonas town (www.birstonas.lt). Birštonas is located in the centre of South Lithuania, 93 km from Vilnius. It is a well-known holiday resort, one of the most beautiful places in Lithuania boasting its nice surroundings within the regional park of Nemunas Loops, pure mineral water resources, clean and not polluted air.

The conference continues the tradition which started at the University of Tartu (Estonia) in 1989. The aim of the conference is to unite efforts of the researchers in the area of subtle human and nature interactions. We invite you to present your paper or just to participate at the conference!

Conference topics:

- structures of biogeofields
- geopathic stress
- electrosmog (technogenic stress)
- environmental health
- methods of detection
- methods of reduction and harmonization
- information fields
- human and nature interaction.

The Conference will be focused on the study of geopathic stress caused by anomalies of natural and artificial biogeofields (especially electromagnetic stress) and methods of its detection and removal (radiesthesia, dowsing, instrumental methods, mental-information processing etc). It includes the study of periodic structures of Earth's fields anomalies and phenomenon's, informational properties of water and geo-bio systems, influence of electrostatic and electromagnetic fields radiation on human health, methods and equipments of their investigation, application of dowser-methods in geology, archaeology, architecture and environmental health. A special attention will be paid for understanding of weak but very significant interactions between human and nature, which may cause problems regarding a complex human psychophysical constitution. It also will include discussion about interactions between human beings, nature, culture and social-psychological values.

Article submission

Extended deadline for paper submission: **April 24, 2017**.

Special excursions and practical exercises will be organized in the Birštonas environs (e.g. in the Nemunas Loops Regional Park etc) with the purpose to observe natural biogeophysical anomalies and energy-informatics peculiarities by the radiesthesic and instrumental methods.

Three languages will be used during the Conference: English, Russian and Lithuanian.

It is anticipated that all participants who arrive to **Vilnius** on **June 15**, 2017 will be ready to leave at **15:00** from the building of the **Institute of Geosciences** of Vilnius University (M.K.Čiurlionio str. 21/27, Vilnius) for a Birštonas guesthouse "**Birštono Tulpė**" (Birutės str. 21, Birštonas, http://www.birstonotulpe.lt). We will organize the transportation (special bus) from Vilnius to Birštonas.

Registration of participants will start on Thursday, **June 15**, in the Institute of Geosciences of Vilnius University, which is situated near the Vilnius centre (M.K.Čiurlionio str. 21/27, http://www.maps.lt/map/default.aspx?lang=lt#q=M.K.%c4%8ciurlionio%20str.%2021/27). The Institute can be easily reached from the Airport by a bus No 2g and by some buses and troleybuses from the Bus and Railway stations: http://www.vilniustransport.lt/en/).

The participants who are not yet registered will be strongly encouraged to inform the Organising Committee about the final decision to participate by e-mail: petrosius@geo.lt not later than April 15, 2017.

Participation Fee

Full participation fee is **170 EUR** (including a copy of the Collection of Articles, 3 nights accommodation in **double room**, full board, coffee breaks, transportation from Vilnius to Birštonas, excursions).

Exception: full participation fee (the same, but accommodation in **single room**) is **270 EUR**. If you request a **reduced** participation fee (excluding full or partial accommodation, board, transportation etc.), please inform us. We shall calculate a particular fee for you.

Transportation

Vilnius can be reached by air from many international airports. The largest in Lithuania Vilnius International Airport (VNO) is located only 7 km away from the Vilnius center. The

VNO can handle about 3 million passengers per year. The airport employs the most famous European airlines such as Lufthansa, Ryanair, Wizz Air, SAS, LOT, Finnair, Brussels Airlines, Austrian Airlines and other companies. In addition, you can reach Vilnius via the Kaunas International Airport which is located at c.100 km distance. 19 European cities can be reached by the cheap Ryanair airlines.

The camera-ready abstracts (and articles) will be published before **June 15, 2017** in a special Abstract and Materials volume. All authors are fully responsible for the scientific and linguistic level of the manuscript. **English** language is preferred, although Russian language can be also used. An abstract or article should not be less than 1 page and more than 10 pages including tables, charts, pictures and **Summary** in alternative language (Russian or English), page size A4. A Summary should not exceed 1 page. It will be preferred to use Microsoft Word including 2003, 2007, 2010 and 2016 versions, Times New Roman font of 12 p. All margins of pages – 2.5 cm. Preferable color of pictures is black & white, format: jpg, tif.
