The First Circular and Invitation

It is an offer to You to participate in the International Conference on „**Earth`s Fields and their Influence on Organisms**“, which will be held in **Birstonas town** (www.birstonas.lt). Birstonas is located in the centre of South **Lithuania**, 93 km from **Vilnius**. It is a well-known holiday resort, situated not far from the international highway “Via Baltica”, within the regional park of Nemunas Loops. It is one of the most beautiful places in Lithuania boasting its nice surroundings, pure mineral water resources, clean and not polluted air.

The conference continues the tradition which started at the University of Tartu (Estonia) in 1989. The aim of the conference is to unite efforts of the researchers in the area of subtle human and nature interactions. We invite you to present your paper or just to participate at the conference!

Conference topics:

- structures of biogeofields
- geopathic stress
- electrosmog (technogenic stress)
- environmental health
- methods of detection
- methods of reduction and harmonization
- information fields
- human and nature interaction.

The Conference will be focused on the study of geopathic stress caused by anomalies of natural and artificial biogeofields (especially electromagnetic stress) and methods of its detection and removal (radiesthesia, dowsing, mental-information processing etc). It includes the study of periodic structures of Earth`s fields anomalies and phenomenon`s, informational properties of water and geo-bio systems, influence of electrostatic and electromagnetic fields radiation on human health, methods and equipments of their investigation, application of dowser-methods in geology, archaeology, architecture and environmental health. A special attention will be paid for understanding of weak but very significant interactions between human and nature, which may cause problems regarding a complex human psychophysical constitution. It also will include discussion about interactions between human beings, nature, culture and social-psychological values.

Article submission

Deadline for paper submission: April 15, 2017.

Special excursions and practical exercises will be organized in the Birstonas environs (e.g. in the Nemunas Loops Regional Park etc) with the purpose to observe natural biogeophysical anomalies and energy-informatics peculiarities by the radiesthetic and instrumental methods.

Three languages will be used during the Conference: English, Russian and Lithuanian.

It is anticipated that all participants who arrive to **Vilnius** on June 15, 2017 will be ready to leave at **15:00** from the building of the Institute of Geosciences of Vilnius University (M.K.Čiurlionio str. 21/27, Vilnius) for a Birstonas guesthouse „**Birštono Tulpė**“ (Birute str. 21, Birstonas, <http://www.birstonotulpe.lt>). We will organize the transportation (special bus) from Vilnius to Birstonas.

Registration of participants will start on Thursday, June 15, in the Institute of Geosciences of Vilnius University, which is situated near the Vilnius centre (M.K.Čiurlionio str. 21/27, <http://www.maps.lt/map/default.aspx?lang=lt#q=M.K.%c4%8ciurlionio%20str.%2021/27>). The Institute can be easily reached from the Airport by a bus No 2g and by some buses and trolleybuses from the Bus and Railway stations: <http://www.vilniustransport.lt/en/>).

The participants will be strongly encouraged to inform the Organising Committee about the final decision to participate by e-mail: petrosius@geo.lt **not later than March 31, 2017**. Also, please inform about your request for bed and meals (single or double room, vegetarian food etc.).

Information on exact conference costs (including bed, meals, registration fee and transportation) will be provided for those participants who have responded in a proper time. It is anticipated that the total costs for one person are estimated do not exceed **170 EUR (double room)** or **270 EUR (single room)**.

A payment invoice will be issued if required.

We will inform you about the revised costs on our website later.

Transportation

Vilnius can be reached by air from many international airports. The largest in Lithuania Vilnius International Airport (VNO) is located only 7 km away from the Vilnius center. The VNO can handle about 3 million passengers per year. The airport employs the most famous European airlines such as Lufthansa, Ryanair, Wizz Air, SAS, LOT, Finnair, Brussels Airlines, Austrian Airlines and other companies. In addition, you can reach Vilnius via the Kaunas International Airport which is located at c.100 km distance. 19 European cities can be reached by the cheap Ryanair airlines.

Abstracts and materials:

The camera-ready abstracts (and articles) will be published before **June 15, 2017** in a special Abstract and Materials volume. All authors are fully responsible for the scientific and linguistic level of the manuscript. **English** language is preferred, although Russian language can be also used. An abstract should not be less than 1 page and more than 8 pages including tables, charts, pictures and **Summary** in alternative language (Russian or English), page size A4. A Summary should not exceed 1 page. It will be preferred to use Microsoft Word including 2003, 2007, 2010 and 2016 versions, Times New Roman font of 12 p. All margins of pages should be 2.5 cm. Preferable color of pictures is black & white, format: jpg, tif. Please send one copy of your text (in Microsoft Word) by **e-mail: petrosius@geo.lt not later than April 15, 2017.**
